Quick Guide to Bylaw Amendments

August 2023 vs May 2015

Introduction.

During the summer of 2023, a committee of ten individuals discussed proposed amendments and organized them into four broad categories. After proper advance notification to the Board of Directors, the amendments were approved at their meeting in Baltimore on August 25, 2023. This document provides a general description of each category, a listing of the items in each category, and a reference to where each listed item may be found in the Bylaws themselves. Any reference to *Robert's Rules of Order* is abbreviated as *Robert's* in this guide.

Category A

This category includes changes related to the timing of elections, the terms of office, definitions of types of meetings and reporting of Executive Committee actions.

Category B

The category includes changes so that our ByLaws conform to the revised governance structure of the ACBL relating to the creation of the Advisory Council and the Regional Director, and the elimination of the District Director. This category also confirms that the Regional Tournament Manager has been a voting member of the Board of Directors since 2015. The category includes the addition of two additional persons as voting members.

Category D

This category adds an additional section to Article V, made on the advice of Tom Dunck, our attorney and agent in filings with the Commonwealth of Virginia. Our ByLaws, in Article VI, Letter D already specify that electronically connected participants count towards a quorum. The new section confirms that actions taken by the Board electronically are authorized and in conformance with Virginia law.
